

Dear ADA Families,

As of June 11, 2021, Governor Beshear has issued to lift all COVID-19 mandates. DSL will lift mask requirements and social distancing. Masks will be highly encouraged for anyone that is not vaccinated. We are looking forward to welcoming everyone back!

**Arrival:**

- Members enter DSL through the front door (temperature checks and health assessment questions will no longer be required)
- Staff will sign-in each member with our iPad at the front desk, and then members can walk to Sublett Hall to put away their personal items

**Morning Mingle:**

- Morning Mingle will be from 8-9am each day in Sublett Hall. This will be a social time for members and staff to begin our day

**Healthy Movement**

- Because of our class sizes, Healthy Movement will be divided into 2 groups (9am and 10am). It will take place in designated areas outside the building, in Sublett, or in the lounge

**Class**

- Staff will strive to conduct class as typically done pre COVID
- Two staff members will teach/supervise each classroom
- Classroom sizes will be limited to no more than 12 members
- Members should not bring any personal items to class, other than a cellphone or purse. Classroom materials will be provided by our teachers. All other items will remain in the cubbies in Sublett.

**Kitchen**

- Staff will clean the kitchen as normal to keep down the spread of germs as done previously.

### **Lunch**

- Lunch will be divided into 2 groups just like pre-Covid - we will have an 11am group and a 12pm group
- Members will be expected to be as independent as possible while they prepare their lunch in the kitchen and find an available seat in Sublett

### **Electives**

- Lead teachers/teachers will lead electives with the same health and safety standards as their morning classes

### **Dismissal**

- Staff assigned to back door dismissal duty will call for members on the walkie-talkie, check out members on Oasis, and complete the driver's log
- Transportation providers will park in the back of the building, in front of the garden area; members will still exit the back door in Sublett

### **Behaviors**

- Staff will use the walkie talkie to call Russ, Shelly, and or Cathy for assistance. For behaviors that cause safety/health issues, Russ, Cathy, or Shelly will make a phone call to parent/guardian regarding behavior.

### **Therapies**

- The therapist will come pick the member up from the classroom and walk up to the front desk to digitally check the member out in Oasis
- Upon completion of the session, the therapist will walk to the front desk, check the member back in to ADA using Oasis, and walk their member back to class

### **Outings/Community Activities**

- Outings and other community activity options will be starting back again soon, just like pre COVID
